THE RESEARCH

The role of the modern security manager: how do they see themselves?

The aim of this project is to explore the modern role of the security manager, both amongst suppliers and within corporates, and specifically to assess how security managers view themselves. Traditionally, security was about the protection of assets, the role of the security manager then was well - albeit narrowly - defined, it was ultimately about protection. More recently though there has been a revision in thinking, security is being seen as an enabler, to help organisations fulfil their objectives via the effective management of risks. There is a new buzz concept, Enterprise Security Risk Management (ESRM) which has (seemingly) yet to be widely adopted. Certainly some argue that business skills are as important as security skills, perhaps more so, but is this really happening? How have these trends impacted on the security manager role? The aim is to explore what does modern security management, in a post-Covid world look like?
